

**Education Health Care  
Plan:**

An EHCP application will take place to provide ongoing support for an individual child.

**School support alongside External Agencies:**

Referrals will be made to a range of different agencies including ASDOT, SLT, OT, ED Psych, Behaviour Improvement team and First response.

**School support- Small group/ 1:1 interventions:**

When a need is identified by a teaching member of staff, children will receive access to small group interventions in a range of different skills. Children will be formally assessed using a range of different assessment strategies appropriate to their need. These can include; writing, reading, phonics, speech and language, social skills, behaviour management, anger management, nurture groups, project x, numicon, relaxation.

**Quality First Teaching:**

At St Ursula's all children access our at least good, quality first teaching. This is monitored regularly using our school policy for monitoring teaching across the range of curriculum subjects. All of our lessons are differentiated ensuring that any misconceptions are addressed within lessons and we have a whole school policy on marking and feedback, which extends children's learning further. Our Learning support assistants (LSA's) target focus children as identified by their class teacher, within lessons on a rotation basis so that all children benefit from their expertise.
